Worship Ministry Spotlight — Howard Tyree

The main reason we come to church is to worship, and my primary responsibility is to make sure our worship services are organized each week. That includes lining up people to participate in services, and making sure they're at services on the week they're supposed to serve, or finding a replacement when they don't show up. There's also a lot going on behind the scene during the week. I make most of our slides for the worship service and for special events, such as funerals. I start on Tuesdays and Wednesdays with our announcement slides, and Thursdays and Fridays, usually add our song slides, then the sermon slides. On Saturdays, I add the Picture of the Week... before sending them out to participants. I record the sermons each week and edit them, before uploading them to the church website. I also make sure our sound, visual projectors, and screens around the building are maintained and are working properly. And when they don't, I either take them in for repair or replace them. There are many hours of preparation that go into a single 90 minute worship service...not just by myself, but by all those who participate.
