- What does it mean to you that the Word is "God breathed?"
 - How does understanding that Jesus is the Word change the way you encounter Him in Scripture?
- What initial impressions do you have of Isaiah 30:15? How have you experienced the truth of this verse with Jesus?
- As you reread Hebrews 4:12, what does it mean to you that the Word is sharper than a double-edged sword?
- When Jesus who lives within you connects with Scripture (Jesus as the Word), what can you expect?
