We use around 16 billion paper coffee cups each year in the U.S., most of which aren't recyclable due to their plastic lining. If just 1% of people switched to reusable mugs, we could save an estimated 65,000 trees annually. Glass, unlike most plastics, is 100% recyclable and can be reused indefinitely without losing quality. Most plastics, by contrast, can only be recycled once before being downcycled.
