- Maddy Kurschat has been diagnosed with Primary Sclerosing Cholangitis liver disease. She'll be on prednisone for another month then get testing to see if it's helping. She may need additional procedures. Here are her prayer requests—prayers for remission and slowed progression of liver damage, for reduction of her pretty extreme fatigue and abdominal pain, and for her care team since she will be needing them ongoing. Also prayers for her and Ryan to stay strong together through this.
- Howard Tyree had been getting treatment for about 6 months with antibiotics for a lump in his neck which has turned out to be a cracked tooth that developed into an infection and created a cyst. The infection has been eroding the jaw bone. He has surgery on it this Wednesday to remove the tooth and get a bone graft. It will take about 4 months to heal.
- Lee (father of Ruby Dresden's nephews) was in a bad accident and is in the hospital having had injuries to his jaw, ribs, lungs, and spleen. He has a long road to recovery ahead of him and he has been dealing with a lot of pain.
