Elder Spotlight - Mark Wanous

What does it mean to listen to the voice of Jesus? There is a familiar Biblical quote, "you will be ever hearing but never understanding." This originates in Isaiah 6:9 but is referenced by NT writers as well. Jesus used it while teaching the Parable of the Sower. The kind of listening that allows us to recognize God's spirit requires attention and focus. The kind of listening that penetrates our heart and soul requires attention and focus. The kind of listening that can change our life for the better requires attention and focus. The kind of listening that produces understanding requires attention and focus. The idea conveyed by the word understanding is having the knowledge to put something together. With understanding we grasp how the parts fit together and how these parts produce something greater than each individual piece. This kind of listening suggests that we obey the voice that we hear. The voice of Jesus (the Word) and spirit of God cause us to submit to His will, by evaluating our motives and desires (our will). Finally, whatever is true, honorable, right, pure, lovely, admirable, if anything is excellent or praiseworthy, then it deserves our attention and focus. Have a blessed week.
