Ministry Spotlight—WRCC Missions Update

WRCC sends funds quarterly to the following:

Brazil - In one way or another we have supported the effort in Brazil for many years (ask Al Henry!) and at this time we send funds to the Charlie Huffman School of Preaching. In 2024 there were 16 students on campus and 10 on-line. Funds are sent to the Kingwood Church of Christ in Murfreesboro, Tennessee where they're directed to Brazil.

Young Life - This organization works with our young population. "More than one million kids in over 100 counties are impacted every year". WRCC helps monetarily and we've also provided meals at youth gatherings here in Midland.

Schults Lewis - Child & Family Services in Valparaiso, IN. A mission WRCC has partnered with for many years, we continue to see their continued work with families. In 2024 WRCC youth spent a few days at Schults Lewis doing projects (painting, trimming shrubs, weeding, cleaning, etc.). WRCC also every summer does a commodity drive.

COC Disaster Response - "You are helping to meet basic individual needs (food, water, personal care, cleaning kits, school kits, and baby care items) of people affected by a disaster. Because DRT (Disaster Response Team) joins forces closely with local congregations in the disaster area, the emotional and spiritual needs can be met for months and years to come". This team sends trucks of supplies all over the country after disasters.

Other Individual Items:

\$400 to Schults Lewis for new washer/dryer, \$1,500 to Rochester University, \$115 to Special Olympics, \$650 to Haiti minister for two-years rent
