Warmup: When you hear the word "destiny," what images, phrases, or thoughts come to mind?

READ I Peter 2:9, Isaiah 28:16

- Who are the recipients of Peter's epistle, I and 2 Peter?
 - o Why could it be challenging for these brothers and sisters to think of themselves as chosen?
- Based upon I Peter 2:9, what is Peter asking these believers to do?

REFLECT

• Explain how Isaiah 28:16 and I Peter 2:5-6 offer you encouragement.

Invite each person into 10 minutes of solitude.

- Read the verse
- Respond to each point answering: How does the truth of this Scripture affect my current situation?
- John 14:23 You're on Team Jesus
- John 16:13 The Holy Spirit leads you to all truth
- John 17:20 Jesus has prayed for YOU

RESPOND

- In what areas of your life have you convinced yourself that you are unchosen?
- Move around, take some deep breaths, and invite the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit to speak truth into your unchosen-ness. What do you hear?
- Read John 15:16 and Isaiah 28:16: Based upon these verses what is your destiny?
- On the back of this paper, record a grateful response to God, then record two action steps you will take this week in regard to the Scripture and the discussion within your Life Group.
