Grant Submission and Evaluation Process

- 1. All grant requests must be submitted electronically, no later than the end of the day, on or before April 1st, and October 1st.
 - Download the form at www.lifeatctk.org/foundation
- 2. The Foundation President will review grant requests as they are received, for completeness. Funding decisions on grant requests will be deferred until completion of the following steps:
 - a. Global Missions
 - b. Following the grant submission deadlines of April 1 and October 1. The CTK Foundation Board will review grant requests and determine whether further information is needed. If further information is required, a board member will follow up with the applicant to clarify the Board's understanding of the grant request.
 - c. The CTK Foundation Board will make final funding decisions on the vetted grant requests at the June and December meetings.
 - d. Grant applicants will be notified of the Board's funding decisions by the President of The Foundation Board.
- 3. The CTK Foundation Board will award grants based on the foundation asset holdings on December 31st of the prior fiscal year.
- 4. Funding will be distributed among the following categories:
 - a. Christ The King congregational needs
 - b. Community needs
 - c. Global Missions
- 5. At the discretion of the CTK Foundation Board, requestors of non-funded grant requests submitted during the first award period of the fiscal year, may be encouraged to resubmit their requests for reconsideration during the second award period.

- 6. In the event that a grant request is made under extenuating circumstances, the CTK Foundation Board may decide to approve and fund a grant at any time during the year.
- 7. Grant recipients must submit an outcome report, preferably with pictures, within a year of receiving the grant. A letter will be sent at time of the initial grant, and again at the end of the year, reminding grantee of the due date for this report.
