AWARD AMOUNT

Two (2) scholarships with a minimum amount of \$2,500.00 (non-recurring)

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS & CRITERION

- Must be an active member in a Fourth District Church that is in "Good Standing." Good Standing means to be actively involved in district calendar events/activities, and current in financial support of the Association
- High school graduate by the end of the Spring semester of the current year, and plan to begin his/her post-secondary training no later than the fall semester of the current year
- High school cumulative GPA of 2.75 or above
- Scholarship award must be used toward the recipient's college education
- Must be enrolled as a full-time student (12 credit hours or more)
- ACT Composite Score of 20 and above

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

- Official high school transcript through first semester of senior year
- ACT Score
- Two (2) signed letters of recommendation: (1) Parish President / Pastor / or Sunday school teacher; and (2) School Guidance Counselor or Teacher that knows candidate very well
- Completed scholarship application
- Two (2) pages typed, double-spaced essay on your life activities and future goals. Explain why you deserve this scholarship and indicate how the church has been an influential factor in your life.
