'<u>To Trust or Not to Trust?</u>'

When we face fears in life, will we trust God or not?

1. 13:1-25

- Find out about the opposition: God works through us
- Find out about the land: God has already kept his promise in part

2. 13:26-14:10a

- the 10 let their fear outweigh their faith and infect others with fear
- the 2 encourage others to have faith and not give into their fear

3. 14:10b-12

- the heart of the problem: disbelief that leads to disobedience
- despite the evidence: our faith is not blind faith
- so God is justified to destroy them: or have we forgotten who God is?

4. 14:13-19

- Moses prays for God's honour: do we pray for this too?
- Moses prays according to God's revelation: do we pray using the Bible?

5. 14:20-45

- God mercifully forgives as a nation, but justly judges the first generation
- Yet they again disbelieve and disobey

Big Application (Hebrews 3:12-19)

- don't do an Israel 1.0, having an unbelieving heart that turns away
- do encourage each other, like the 2 not the 10
- do remember God's past deeds in your life and through Christ!

May we not let our fears outweigh our faith, but trust in Jesus to the very end!
