Sept. 29-Oct. 4/ Day 1: Read John 13:1-20:

Q. What are some of the reasons this is significant...why it is not? In what ways does Jesus wash our feet today?

Q. When and why is it difficult for you to serve others?

Sept. 29-Oct. 4/ Day 2: Read Matthew 26:20-29; Mark 14:17-25:

Q. The central emphasis of the Passover meal was traditionally the sacrificial lamb; where did Jesus place His emphasis?

Q. How does Judas' response to Jesus differ from the rest of the disciples?

Q. In what way(s) is Jesus still a "teacher" in your life and not "Lord?"

Sept. 29-Oct. 4/ Day 3: Read Luke 22:14-30:

Q. Why is the Lord's supper important for us to observe?

Q. In what area of your life to you want to be the greatest? What acts of service could you do in this area?

Sept. 29-Oct. 4/ Day 4: Read John 13:21-30:

Q. How would it feel to be betrayed by a close friend?

Q. How does John's account of this event differ from the other Gospel's?

Q. What can you do to build trust in all your friendships?

Sept. 29-Oct. 4/ Day 5: Read Luke 22:31-38; John 13:31-38:

Q. What does it mean for you to love people as Jesus loved them?

Q. Why might Jesus have them prepare (money, swords, etc.) when He specifically told them not to earlier, as He reminded them?

Sept. 29-Oct. 4/ Day 6: Study and Meditation – Consider the following questions:

Q. Who is someone you need to love as Jesus has loved them?

Q. How will you prepare for the Lord's Supper the next time you observe it?
