People often say, "It's about the journey, not the destination," when their travel plans don't work out how they expected. This phrase couldn't have been more true for Job, who went through a shocking journey. In this 4-week series, kids will hear from Job's story as he learned to navigate loss and trust God's itinerary every step of the way. Through the story of Job's perseverance and faithfulness, VineKids will learn that **God is with them no matter what they go through, they can show God's love in small ways, God is bigger than they could ever understand, and they can trust God will make everything right.**

- What did Job's friends do when they saw what had happened to Job? Why do you think they did this?
- What are some ways that you can show God's love to someone who might be going through a hard time?

This week, kids see how **God spoke to Job** about his suffering.

- **BIG IDEA:** God is bigger than we could ever understand.
- **BIBLE:** Job 38:1–7, 34–41; Matthew 6:25–34



REMEMBER

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ASK THIS

Because sometimes you and your VineKid need a conversation-starter that isn't, "So . . . how was church?"

- Who created the earth and measured it? Why do you think God asked Job this question and others like it?
- What are some of the things you worry about that you can turn over to God instead of worrying about them?

WEEK 4

We can trust God will make everything right.

Job 42:1–17; Mark 10:46–52

- **BIG IDEA:** We can trust God will make everything right.
- **BIBLE:** Job 42:1–17; Mark 10:46–52

This month, your VineKid(s) is memorizing the Bible verse **Psalm 121:8 (NIV)**, in case you want to work on them

- What are some things you want to see made right in the world around you?

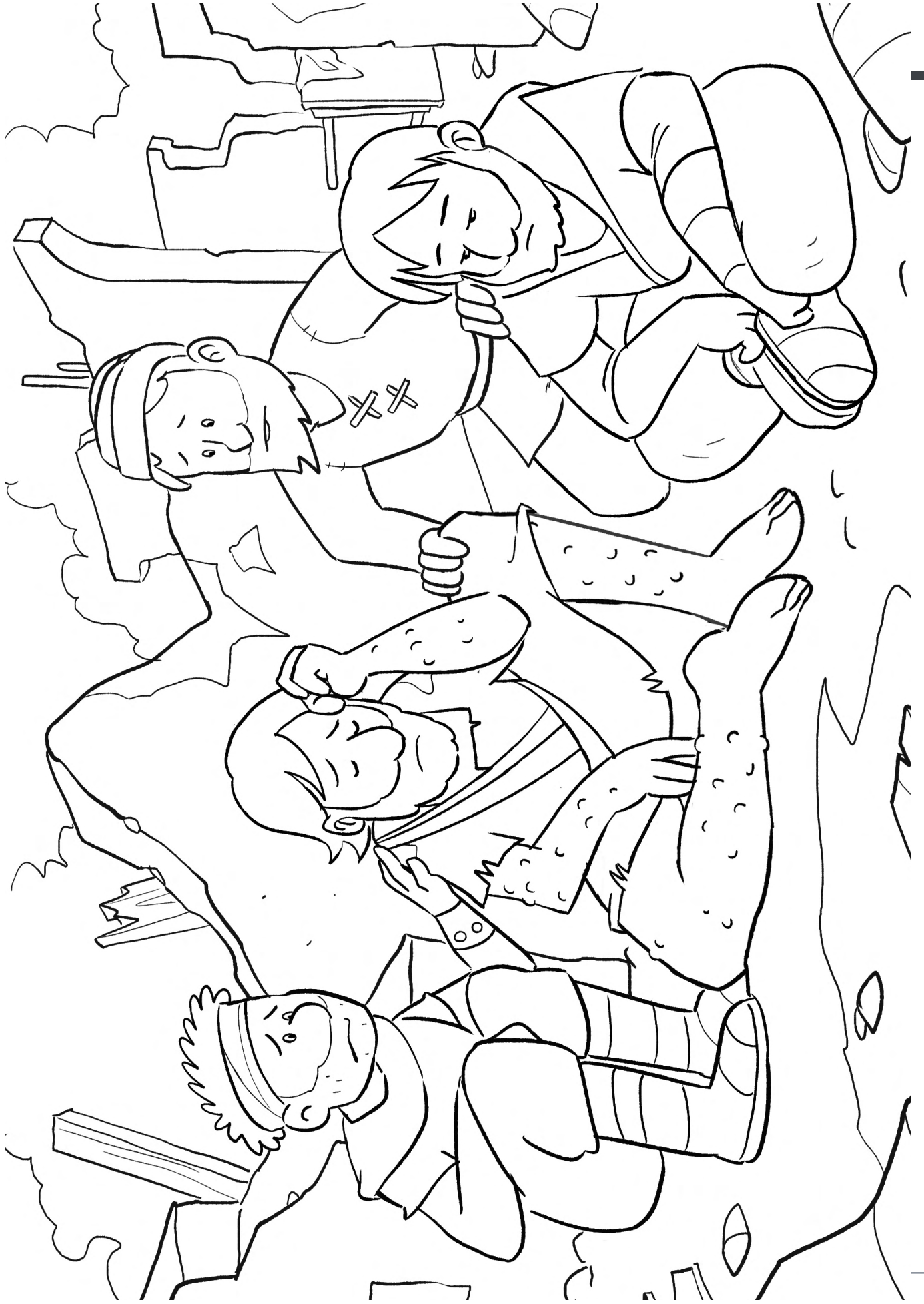
